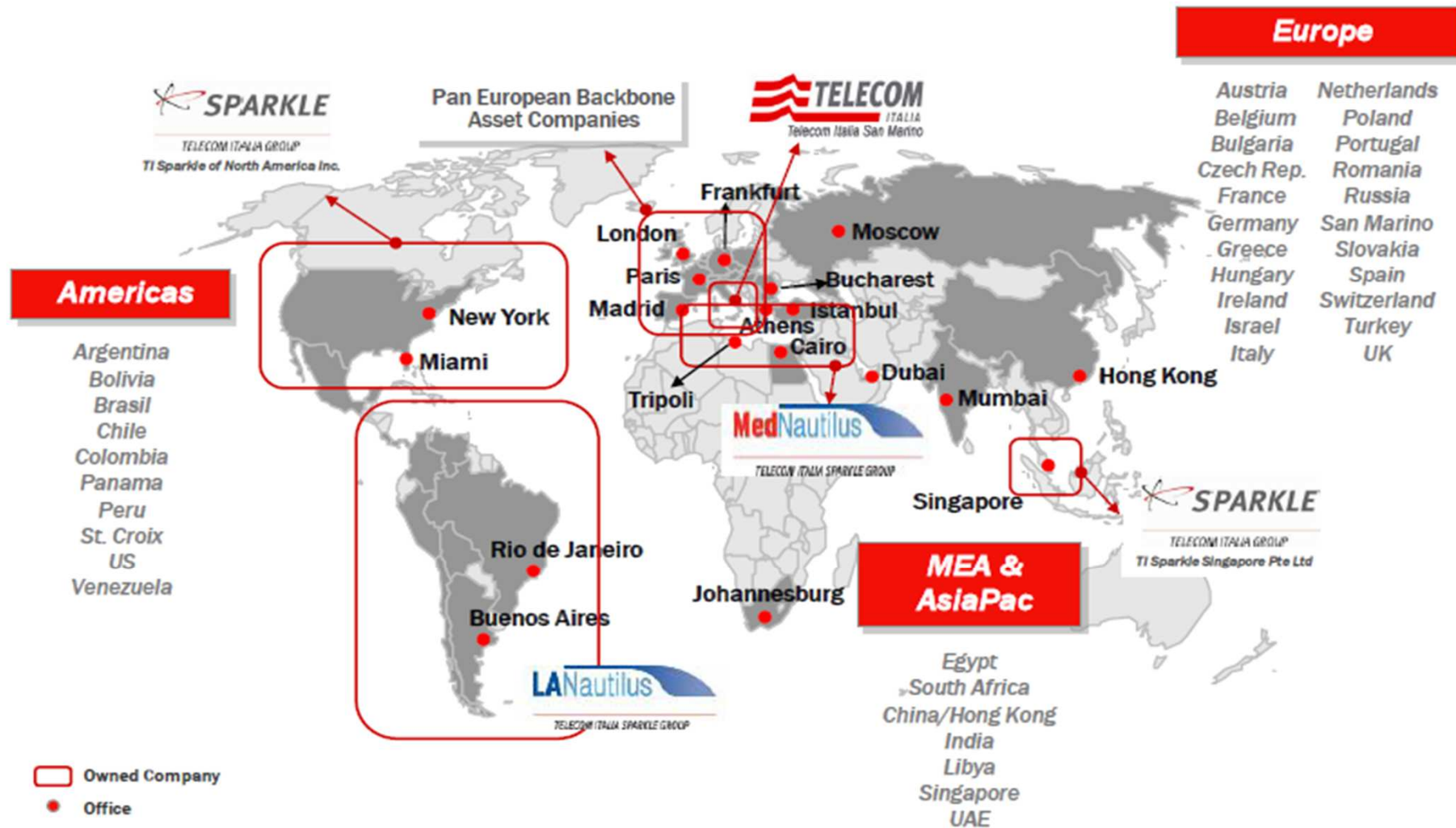

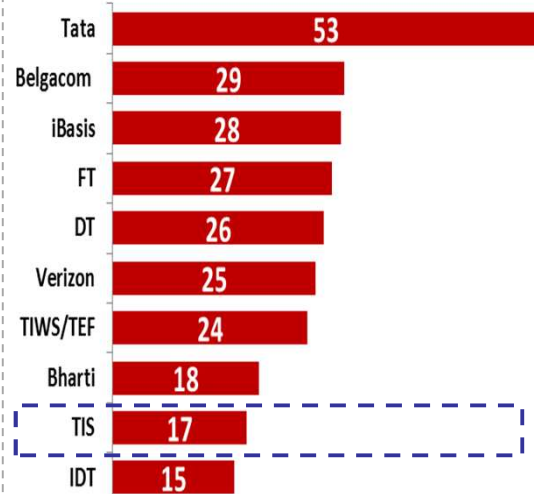

2012 Bn Mins – Traffic volumes worldwide



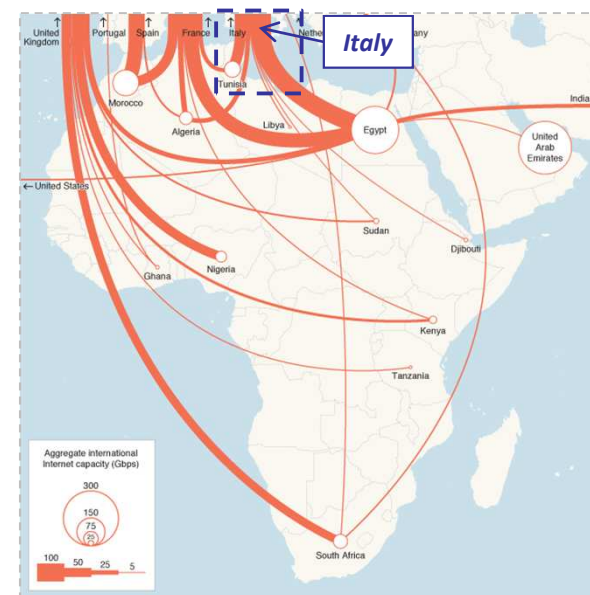

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Major Trends in the Telecom Industry



New Areas of Growth from IT based services



- The increasing power of IT and IT outsourcing demand (boosted by customers cost cutting policies) are key drivers for incremental growth in a border TLC/IT segment like Cloud
- The explosion of multimedia and bandwidth-hungry contents and applications is continuously pushing towards efficient Content Distribution Network Solutions.
- Among IT outsourcing services, Cloud, as it is replacing traditional DC and web/managed hosting services, is expected to grow at ~ 45% yearly.
- Multiplicity of mobile smart devices, connected/interactive TV will boost traffic growth which represents both a threat and an opportunity for Telcos

With less than half of 2007 costs, the NGDC now delivers 50% more applications.

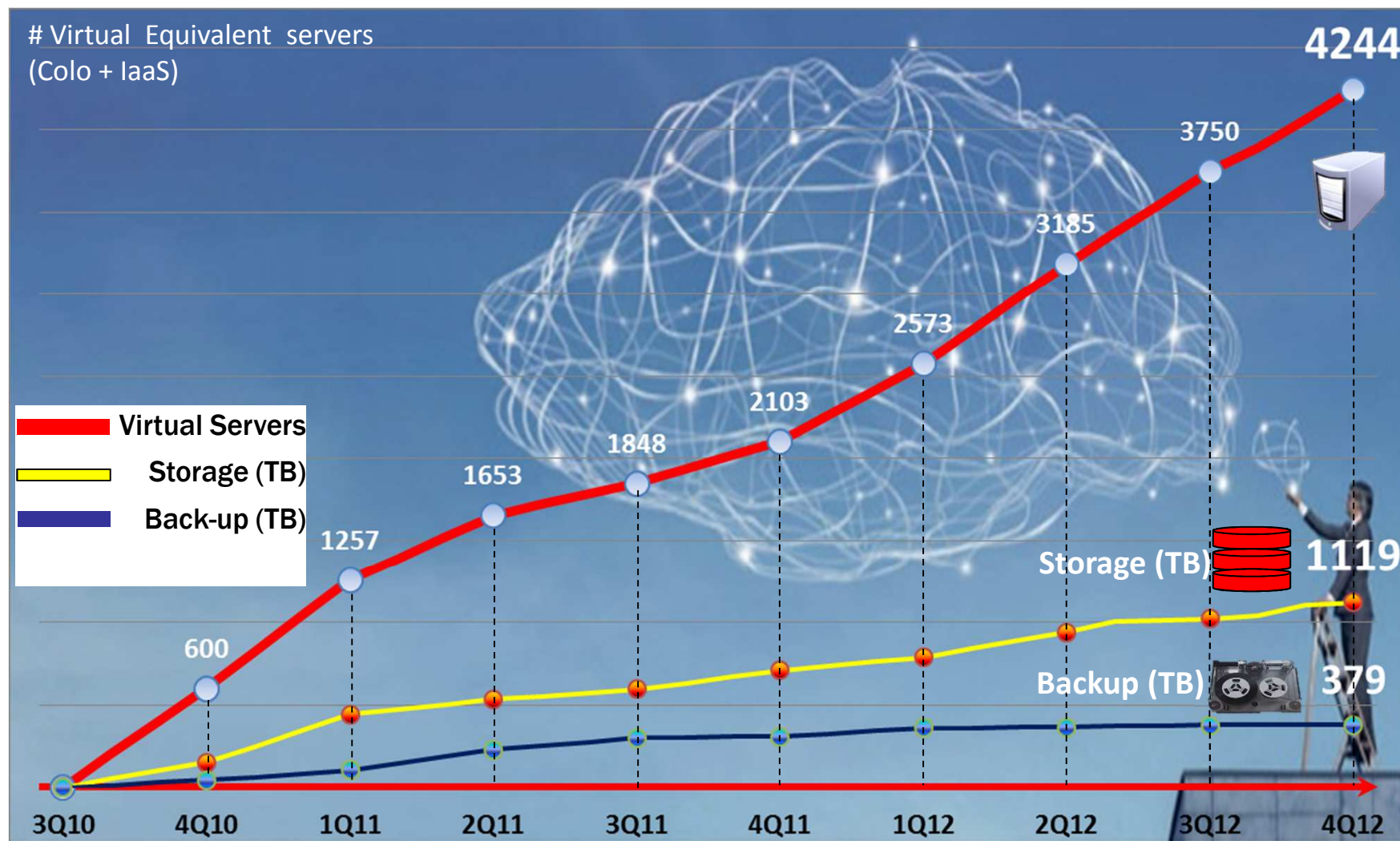
