South American operators will also be able to access these DE-CIX sites with premium transport solutions over Sparkle's American backbone, a state of the art network featuring next generation submarine cables – Seabras-1 in the Atlantic and Curie in the Pacific – ensuring ultrafast and protected connectivity between South and North America.

At the same time, DE-CIX customers will be able to benefit from Sparkle's global Tier-1 IP Transit service Seabone for global Internet connectivity. Sparkle's offer to the DE-CIX community is also complemented by its DDoS Mitigation & Cleaning solutions – which grant Seabone customers the option to protect their network – and by City2City, which offers dedicated and secure transport solutions to the main urban centers worldwide.

The selected DE-CIX locations in the United States add to the IXPs in Los Angeles, New York, Dallas, Sao Paolo, Rio De Janeiro and Santiago del Chile already interconnected by Sparkle, improving the coverage of Sparkle's Virtual NAP service in America.
